Explore Christchurch

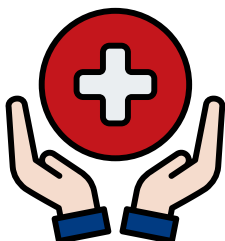
There is so much to see and do around the city during Games Week.

Wolfbrook Arena – Opening Ceremony

If you are unable to collect beforehand, you can pick up your accreditation on arrival at the Opening Ceremony from 3.00pm.

Please note:

- You must be wearing accreditation to access the designated Family/Friends seating area
- We strongly recommend arriving no later than 3.15pm if you need to collect it, so you have plenty of time to reach your seat for the 4.00pm start
- Family/friends without accreditation can still attend the Opening Ceremony and all sports, but will be seated in public seating areas
